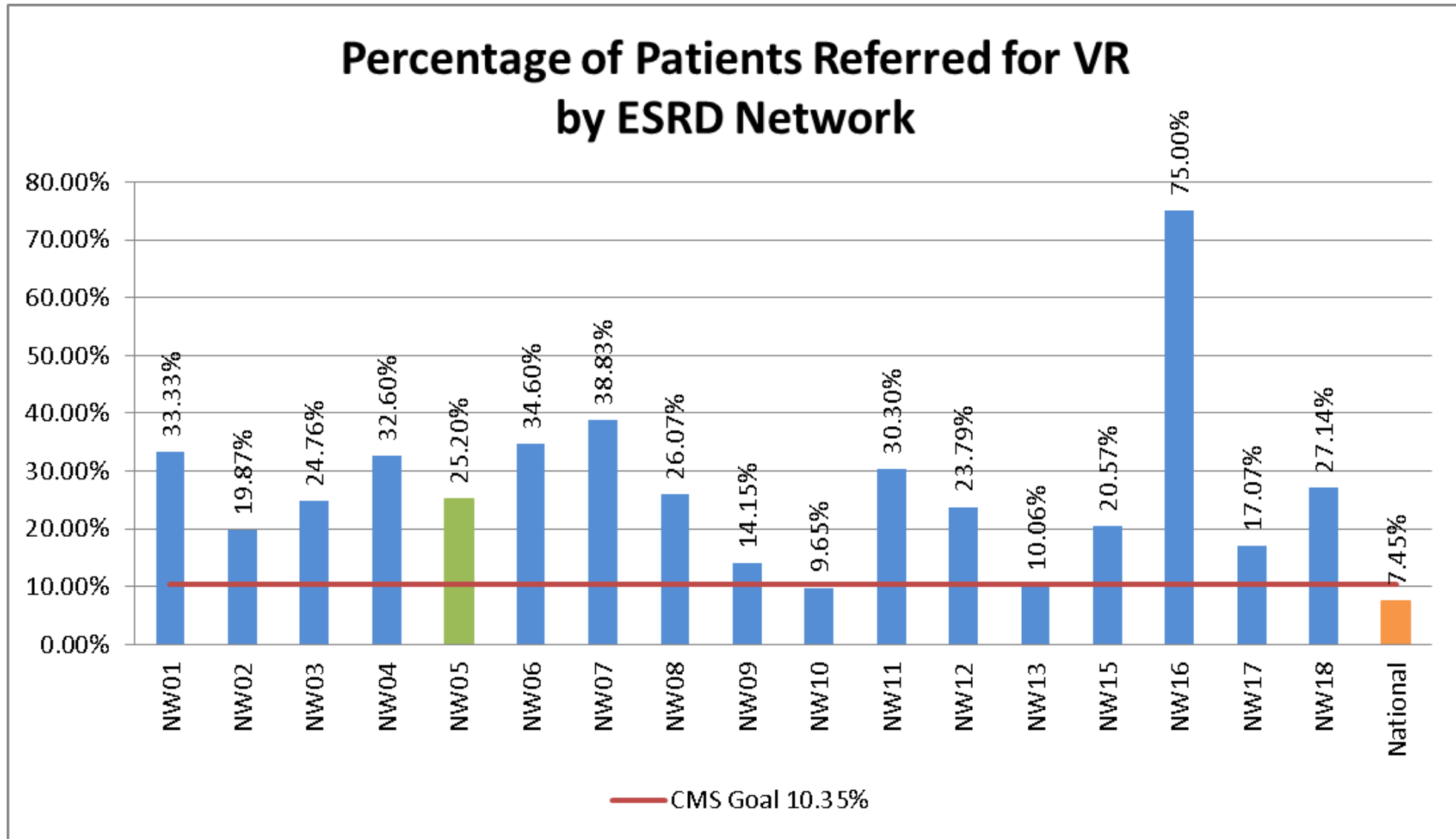

- What is a Sharing Call?

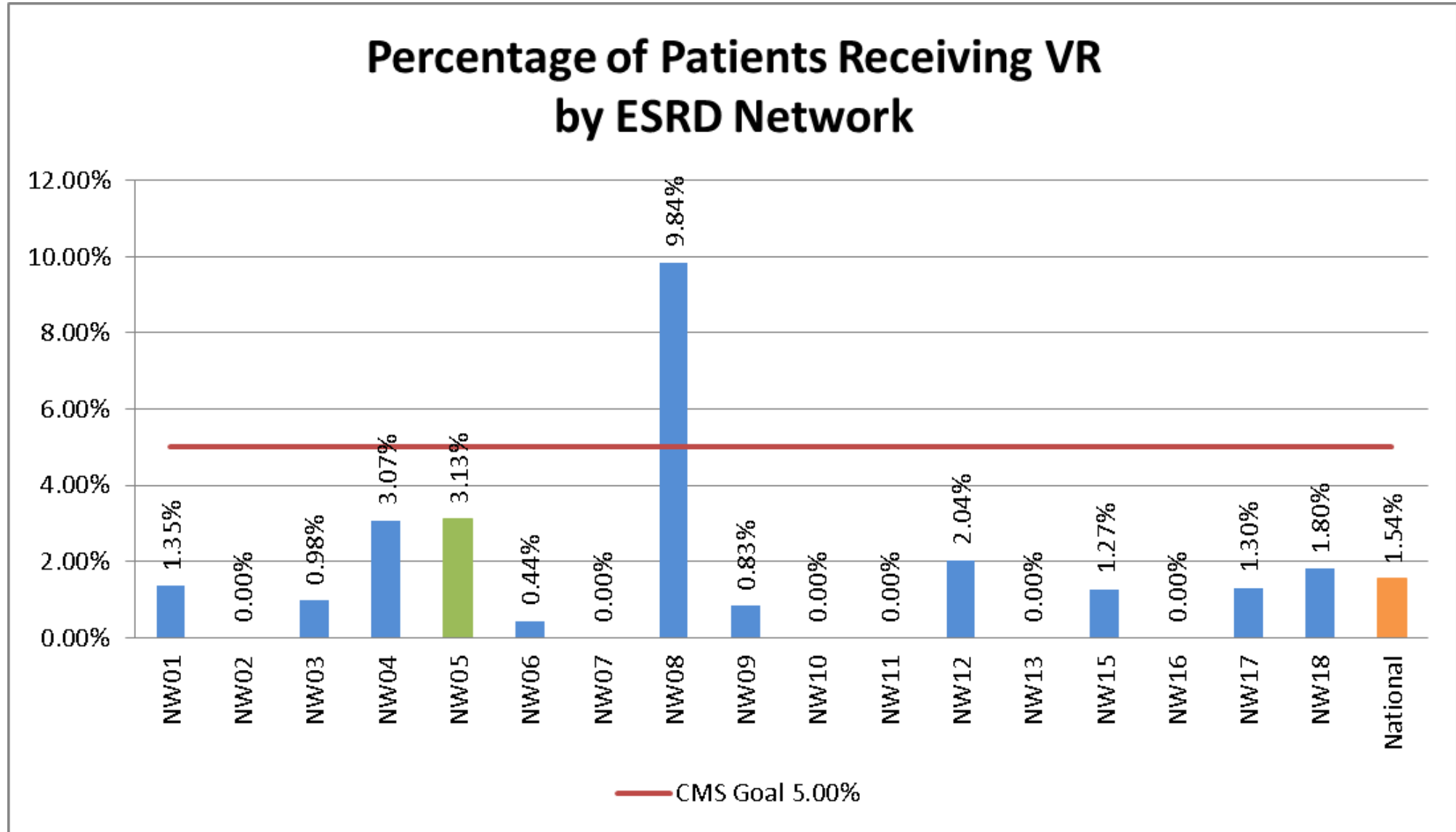
A forum that allows for attendees to engage in collaborative dialogue and constructive conversation. Read, "Judgment free zone".

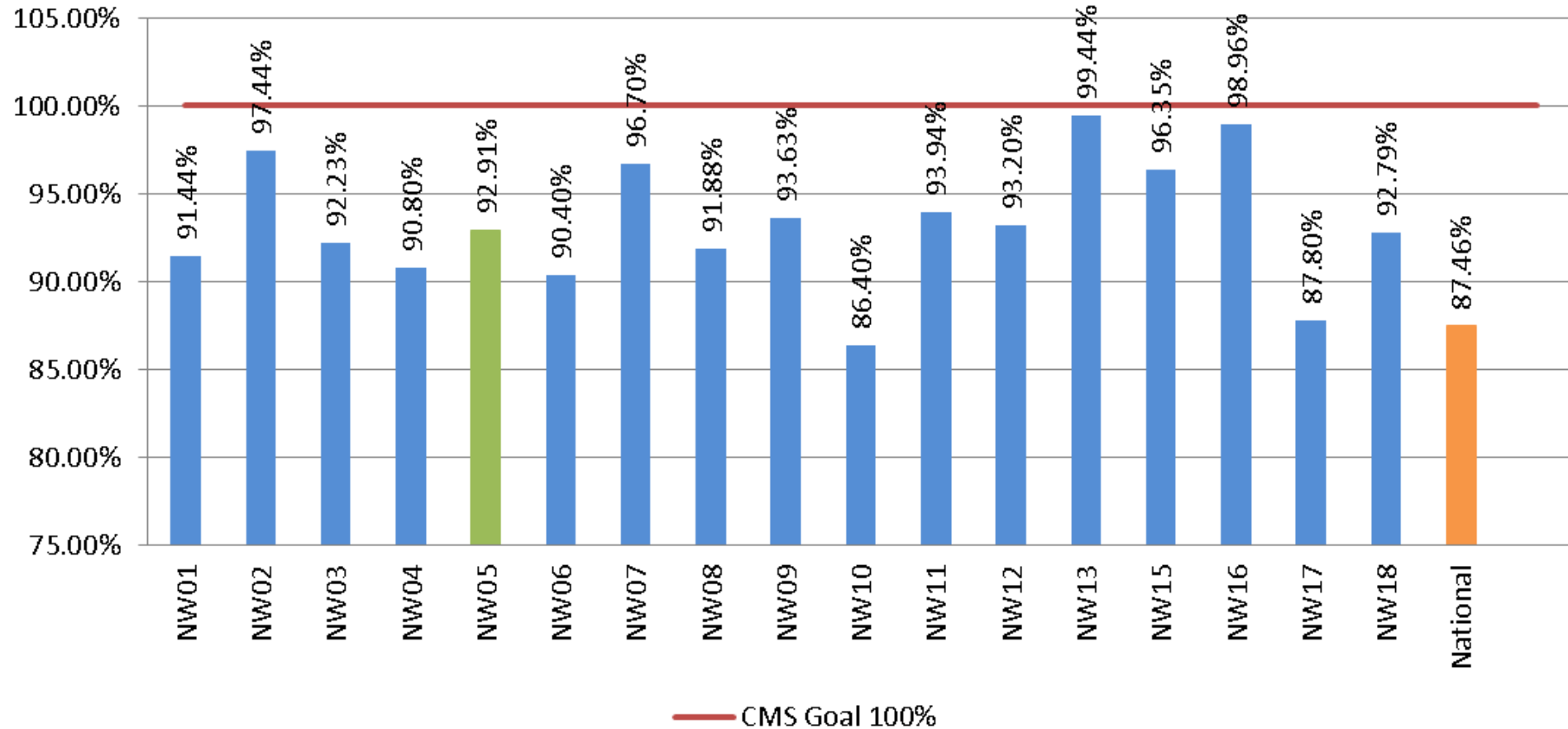
