Emergency Checklist

- **1.** Make sure the dialysis clinic has your correct address and contact information.
- 2. Keep extra chargers for your cell phone.
- **3.** Text messaging uses less power and can usually get through when calls can not.
- **4.** Have family, friends, and neighbors check on you during emergency events.
- **5.** Keep a non-cordless phone in your home. It is likely to work when power is out.
- **6.** Subscribe to an alert service.
- **7.** Listen to your radio or TV for the latest information.
